Story telling

You could practice the story and then put on a show for your family. Make up your own actions too. Sequencing a story is a big part of learning how stories work so this is really important! Maybe you could draw a story map of the story. A story map example is pictured beside you (but I bet you can draw better!)

I have spotted some beautiful flowers outside and have been listening to the birds singing. Can you spot the signs of Spring? Can you draw a picture of what you find and get your grown up to label the picture (maybe you could have a go at sounding out some of the little words yourself.)
