### Maths Workbook

### Decorate your own butterfly

You can cut out a butterfly shape (Just like Andy did in the puppet Butterflies video) decorate one side with paint, fold it over and see what happens. If you don't have paint you can decorate your butterfly with anything. Colouring, stickers, glue, glitter...Just make sure both sides are the same, like a real Butterfly

### Caterpillar creations

You can make caterpillars in many different ways. You can thread beads onto string, thread pasta onto string (you can even paint that afterwards too.) Find any small round objects

(an empty toilet roll works great for this) and draw round them or paint and print your own caterpillars. You can decorate an old egg box too and turn it into your own caterpillar. Use bricks, Lego, Duplo...to create your own caterpillar. You can also make caterpillars from your snacks. Anything you have in the house can be used to create 😊
