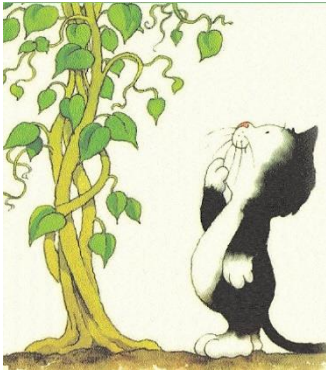


Nursery home learning
