Password: ThamesideN

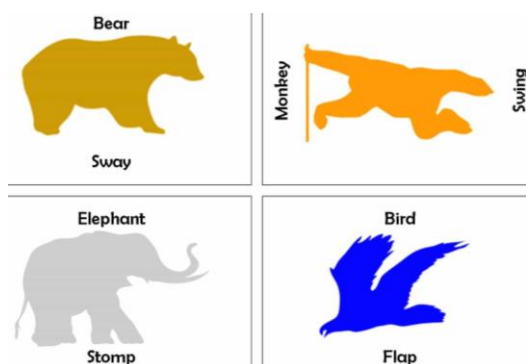
